Scouts are encouraged to attend. They DO NOT have to campout overnight, they can just come for the day.

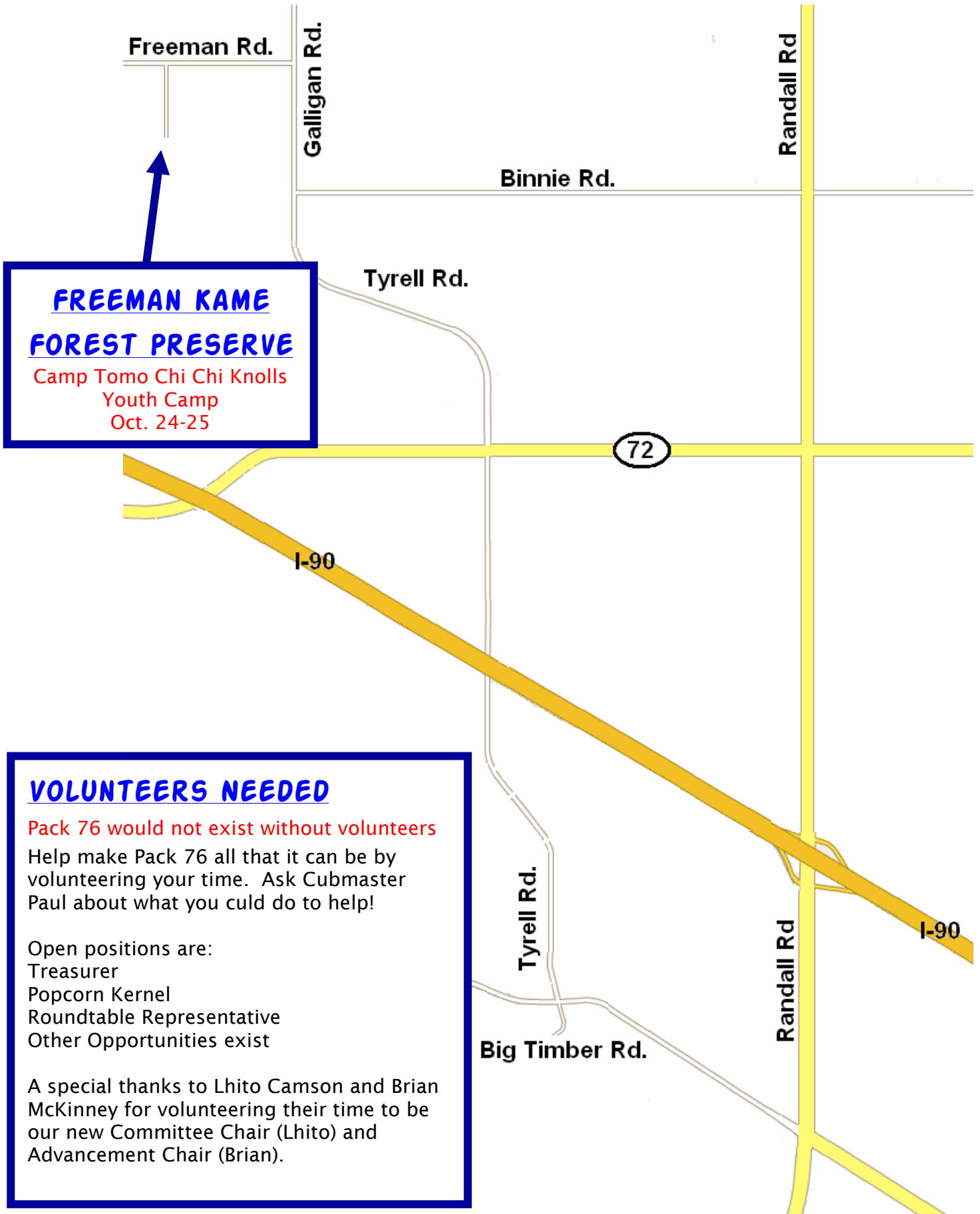
